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On behalf of the Teulon & Area Farmers Market board we welcome you to our 2014 season! We look forward to you being a part of our Farmers Market family for years to come!

Here is a copy of our Market Rules and Regulations for you to keep on hand for reference to help ensure our market runs smoothly. If you have any questions on what can be made or sold at our market please refer to the Manitoba Farmers Market Association Guidelines that can be found on our website.

The Teulon and Area Farmers Market is a traditional market where vendors must “make it, bake it or grow it”. Our volunteer board works hard to make the market successful and we always have the best interests of all our vendors in mind. We are a non-profit Market in which all fees paid go directly into making the Teulon and Area Farmers Market bigger and better with each growing season. Exceptions to the make it, bake it, grow it rule may be made when presented to the board. We will not accept “garage sale” items; or home sales companies. We love having a diverse and vibrant market and we invite you to attend for one week or the entire season. Thank you for joining us!

Market Rules and Regulations

1. All vendors must be approved before acceptance.
2. The FM Board reserves the right to refuse vendors and to request that a vendor does not return. Member fees would not be returned.
3. All vendors must submit an annual \$25 membership fee, along with their signed market application/contract. Membership includes market insurance, advertising and promotion.
4. All vendors must submit a \$10 fee for every Friday they attend the market. Site fee includes a 10x10 foot space as well as a Farmers Market canopy when available. We have 10 tents. Your fees also cover all our marketing and promotion. All money goes back into the market.

5. Canopies are available on a first come, first serve basis. Vendors are responsible for setting up their own canopy. Vendors may purchase or bring their own canopy if they wish.
6. All vendors must supply their own tables, chairs, display materials and bags.
7. The market will only provide power if extremely necessary, example: freezers. You must bring your own long extension cords (100 feet) to run across the parking lot from Delucas. Please be aware that cars run over the cords; they must be laid so customers will not trip.
8. There are washroom facilities for use by the vendors and their helpers but not for customers. No one is allowed to "hang out" inside the building.
9. All vendors supplying edible goods must follow the Manitoba Farmers Market Association (FMA) guidelines. No exceptions. Copies of guidelines are available on our website.
10. Market will run rain or shine. In the event of extreme weather, the TAFM reserves the right to cancel. If you are a regular vendor we will do our best to contact you otherwise please contact Lana or Darci.
11. All vendors will not make, and or sell duplicated products made by another vendor from his or her own pattern. Do not copy what another vendor sells; we strive for a balance of goods.
12. Vendors who introduce a new item to sell which they did not put on the application must have board approval first.
13. All vendors and purchasers will be covered by the public liability insurance under the policy by the Manitoba Farmer Markets Association.
14. All vendors are responsible for keeping their own site clean and free of garbage. Market will supply garbage cans.
15. Take down: All vendors are required to take down his or her canopy tend and take into the building. Please assist in taking down the signs (in the ditch) and putting away.
16. When vendors are finished unloading their goods for setup, they must return their vehicle to the designated general parking area, please leave the closest parking for our customers. No parking by the canopies.
17. All vendors are free to set their own prices however we ask that you be respectful of your fellow vendors. For example if someone has never been a vendor and has a huge crop of (any veggie) that they want to get rid of, they will not be welcome to come and hugely discount this product in competition to the fellow vendors. But if you are a regular vendor and 6 pm you have an abundance of (any veggie) that you want to be cleared out, please use your discretion.
18. All vendors agree to keep their booth open during market hours of 3-7 pm. If you leave early you may not be invited back.
19. All vendors are to be set up in full and ready to sell by 2:45pm. There are always customers arriving early, so this rule will only benefit you, the seller!
20. Vendors must maintain a positive attitude. Disrespectful or negative behavior to customers, other vendors or the board will not be tolerated and you may not be invited back.
21. Any issues, problems or concerns are to be brought to the attention of Lana Knor or Darci Loehmer to be dealt with accordingly. Please remember we are only volunteers who are vendors as well.
